


National Air & Space Camp objectives

Camp Background



- Born in 2015 as a trial camp
- 2016 celebrated the RAF Air Cadets 75th Anniversary
- 2018 a flagship camp to celebrate RAF100
- Due to Covid19 restrictions there was no camp in 2020
- Keen to run a camp in 2021, we revised the delivery model. Not able to accommodate cadets, they travelled daily to Syerston.
- With reduced bed spaces and last-minute accommodation changes, we had to reduce cadet allocations in 2022. We also opened the Industry day to visiting day-cadets.
- In 2023 we accommodated at 2 hub-sites allowing for more bed spaces and welcomed even more day cadets.
