EXAMPLE ANSWERS...

PILOT

Skills required: Leadership, communication, mathematical skills, thinking and reasoning, attention to detail, teamwork, patience, calm in stressful situations.

ENGINEER

Skills required: Pay attention to detail, practical hands-on skills, persistence and determination, patience, remaining calm in stressful situations, communication skills, working with your hands, computer skills.

AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLER

Skills required: concentration skills, sound judgement, decision making, working under pressure, complex problem-solving skills, verbal communication, pay attention to detail, logic, teamwork.

CABIN CREW

Skills required: customer service skills, communication, assertiveness, decision making, empathy, patience, teamwork, friendliness, sensitivity, health and safety.

PASSENGER SERVICE AGENT

Skills required: customer service, technical skills, flexibility, patience, attention to detail, friendliness, communication.

BUREAU DE CHANGE ASSISTANT

Skills required: numeracy skills, organisation, customer service, communication, IT.

BAGGAGE HANDLER

Skills required: Physical fitness, teamwork, time management, customer service, organisation, knowledge of safety and security.

AIRCRAFT FUELER

Skills required: Time Management, teamwork, communication, accuracy.

AIRPORT MANAGER

Skills required: Decision making, communication, motivation, problem solving, forward planning, friendliness, organisation, resilience, honesty.

SECURITY OFFICER

Skills required: Decision making, communication, customer service, problem solving, forward planning, remaining calm in stressful situation, organisation, paying attention to detail.

GROUND STAFF

Skills required: Flexibility, teamwork, communication, customer service, physical skills.
